Brandon Estes, Conductor and Associate Director of Bands

Brandon Estes is up and running as a member of the NCHS staff! Mr. Estes conducts Concert Band and Wind Symphony, and teaches Music Appreciation: Bach to Rock. He will also direct Jazz Lab Band and assists Mr. Alstadt with the Marching Redhawks.



Mr. Estes has been an active arranger, clinician and adjudicator in Chicagoland and various areas in Texas. A native of Houston, he holds a Bachelor of Music in Music Education from Texas State University – San Marcos where he studied in percussion under Genaro Gonzalez, Tony Edwards and John Lopez. He earned his Master's degree in Music Performance-Percussion from Northern Illinois University, where he studied under and was Graduate Percussion Assistant to Professor Robert Chappell and Dr. Gregory Beyer as well as Richard Holly and Liam Teague.

Mr. Estes' extensive drum corps marching experience includes membership with the Pioneer as well as the Madison Scouts Drum and Bugle Corps between 1998 and 2002. In 2005, he also served as Co-Arranger and Percussion Caption Head of the Blue Stars Drum and Bugle Corps. Brandon is currently a member of the Chicago Bears Drumline and a founding member of the Chicago Bulls "Stampede" Drumline. As an orchestral performer, Estes has performed with the Austin Symphony Orchestra, the Chicago Sinfonietta, and currently with the Elmhurst Symphony of Elmhurst, Illinois.

In 2006, Mr. Estes served as Assistant Band Director at Langham Creek High School in Houston, Texas. From 2007 to 2010, he served as General Music Teacher at Lincoln Elementary in Addison, Illinois. In addition to teaching full time as an elementary general music teacher, Mr. Estes served as the composer and marching percussion instructor for the Waubonsie Valley High School Drumline. He also serves on the design team as Battery Coordinator and Snare tech for the Open Class Pioneer Indoor independent WGI marching percussion ensemble.

From the NCHS Band Booster Association President:

The NCHSBBA also has set up a “student account” for each active band student, and remains active until the student graduates from NCHS. If the student has an account balance after four years and has a younger band sibling, their account balance will be transferred to his / her brother or sister. If the student does not have a younger sibling upon his/her graduation, any balance left in the student account will be transferred to the Band Boosters’ General Operating Fund. Funding for the student accounts is done solely through the following fundraising activities: Bears Games, Ad Book Sales, Citrus Fruit Sales and Poinsettia Sales. Funds in a student’s account can be used to pay for band camp fees, private music lessons, instrument purchases, trips such as the Disney World trip, or any other music related activities. For more information about student accounts, please contact our NCHSBBA treasurer, Rod Shoemaker.

I am sad to say that our volunteer base has declined significantly over the past few years and, as a result, our fundraising efforts have suffered. We believe this is due in part to the struggling economy. We had to make the very difficult decision to turn over operation of the NCHS indoor concession stand to the athletic boosters (although we are attempting to work with them to provide manpower for some events this winter as a small fundraiser). We try not to do too many fundraisers that involve sales – instead, we look for fundraisers that involve volunteer hours. As I am sure you all know, band can be an expensive activity. The Band Booster Association works very hard to raise funds to help offset the cost of running a first class band program, while trying to do some fundraisers that help students build their student accounts.

If you are a current volunteer, I wish to thank you again! If you haven’t volunteered, or if it’s been awhile, please consider lending a hand. I guarantee you will make many great new friends, have lots of fun and – most importantly – help our well-deserving band students soar to new levels! Below are some of the ways you can help.

Bears Games. We have been given an outstanding opportunity to work Bears home games, clearing and wiping down tables in the Stadium Club at Soldier Field. The work is easy, transportation to and from the game is provided by the band boosters and a meal and drinks are provided at Soldier Field. Pursuant to Soldier Field regulations, only adult family members of band students or Spirits may volunteer for this fundraiser. The band booster association earns \$75.00 per person per game, and to help families, a contribution of \$25.00 will be added to the student account of each parent volunteering. The 2010 schedule is posted on the Main Calendar at www.nchsbands.info. Contact Margaret Donahue for more information and to sign up!

In addition to raising funds for the NCHS Band Programs, band booster parents provide refreshments at concerts; assist the marching band with equipment, props and uniforms at competitions, home football games and parades, organize and assist with potluck dinners and picnics, Jazz Cafe, Drumshow,

the NCHS Solo & Ensemble Extravaganza, Spring Awards, and other special events; produce a quarterly newsletter; design and maintain the band’s website, and notify local media of band activities and achievements. The following positions are open - **Special Events Chairperson(s) (1-2 people):** Responsible for organizing various “special events” that occur throughout the year, such as the Ice Cream Social in the summer, Jazz Café, Judge’s Hospitality at the Marching Classic in the fall and Solo & Ensemble in the spring. (Full year commitment.)

Media Communications Coordinator: Responsible for contacting local news media and the District 203 media department (“Talk 203”) regarding band accomplishments and activities. (Full year commitment.)

Spirit Wear / Merchandise – Helping our coordinator organize and sell band merchandise at selected events, such as Open House, marching band parent presentation, concerts, etc.

Marching Band Uniforms – Help students with their uniforms at home football games and out of town marching band competitions.

Program Book Ad Sales. Students -- you can sell ad space in our Program Book (which is distributed at the NCHS Marching Classic in the fall and at all concerts throughout the year)! The forms can be downloaded from the main page of the website. Students earn 50 percent of all ads they sell for their student accounts. If you have any questions or have ads you wish to turn in, please contact Lori Tucker.

Market Day continues to be a great fundraiser for us. Please consider ordering from Market Day each month. The food is great and pickup times are very convenient. Contact Debbie Klos at deborahdklos@hotmail.com or visit the Market Day website at www.marketday.com for more information.

Citrus Sale. We will be taking orders for Florida citrus fruit (oranges, tangelos, grapefruit) in early fall, for a late fall/early winter delivery. A portion of the total sales will be credited to the student’s student account.

Poinsettia Sale. Our annual Poinsettia Sale will take place again this fall, just before Thanksgiving. The plants will be delivered the weekend before Thanksgiving. This is another great way for your student to earn money for his/her student account!

50/50 Raffle. The 50/50 Raffle at home football games has been another great fundraiser. Moms, dads, alumni, and students are all encouraged to sign up to sell raffle tickets at all NCHS home games. If you are a “people person,” this is a great job for you!

Ribfest and Last Fling. Many students, parents and family members came out this summer to work Ribfest, and are signed up for Last Fling shifts – these are always good fundraisers for the bands!

To sign up to volunteer, please check the calendars for available shifts, and then email Margaret Donahue to sign up. It's fast and it's easy! We do not have online sign-ups, to ensure accuracy of our volunteer needs.

I would love to post new **photographs** in our photo gallery! Please email your photos to me, or you can place them on a CD and drop them in the Band Office with Lori Tucker's name written on it. Mr. Alstadt, Mr. Estes or Mrs. Padmanabhan will make sure Lori gets the CD.

IMPORTANT: If you do not want your band student's name or photograph posted on the website, please send me an email right away! To protect our band students, we never post a student's name with his/her photograph; however, we do list students when recognizing their accomplishments, and we do have hundreds of photographs in our gallery. Unfortunately, try as we may, we do not know all our band students, so if you see a photograph of your child that you would like removed, please let me know and I will remove it immediately.

2010-11 Curricular Band Dress Information

All curricular bands require gentlemen to wear a black tuxedo or black suit, black dress shoes, white tuxedo shirt and black bow tie. All ladies will wear a black velour dress (see below) and black dress shoes. Mrs. Donahue has generously volunteered to collect gently used dresses and band wear items and distribute them on a first come first served basis.

To Donate a Dress: If you are a senior or an alumni and would like to donate your dress to the BBA -- or place the dress on consignment for a new student to purchase, you may do so.

Donate your dress. The BBA will sell used dresses for \$50. Proceeds will benefit NCHS Bands. (You can receive a tax credit for donating to the BBA) .

Place your dress on consignment. The BBA will sell the dress for \$50 and when yours sells, you will receive \$25 of the sale price.

Dresses must be dropped off at Margaret Donahue's home. Please make sure the dress is clean and labeled with your name, phone number and dress size, and indicate whether you are donating the dress or placing it on consignment.
